Founded in 2015 to support Helio Health's role as a leader and innovator in behavioral healthcare. the Helio Health Foundation raises funds and awareness for people working toward recovery from substance use, mental health, and housing challenges.

The Foundation's signature fundraising event, the Run for Recovery 5K and Kids Fun Run, draws nearly six hundred participants from Central New York and beyond, and includes kid-friendly activities, food trucks, prizes, and the opportunity to share and celebrate stories of recovery.

Recent Foundation Grant Awards

Community Integration - Increase quality of life by participating in community activities such as NYS Parks, the zoo, and bowling

Wellness Clinic - Provide health assessments, health education, immunizations, and wellness checks to residents participants to lessen financial burden and provide an in our mental health residential programs

Help on a Shelf - A pantry to distribute food, essential clothing, cleaning products, and sanitary products to

Fitness - *Install basketball hoop, treadmill, and exercise* bike so residents can engage in healthy living activities

Cooking Classes - Residents receive Instant Pots and participate in cooking classes to gain independence as they transition to a lower level of care

Care Baskets - Provide personal care items to program incentive to remain engaged in recovery

Wellness Day - Provide a wellness day to promote overall wellness and self-esteem. Haircuts, guided meditation, health testing, smoking cessation, goody bags and raffles

Summer Picnic - *Special event for mental health residential* participants to enjoy recreation and social wellness. Live music, lawn games, petting zoo, crafts and barbeque lunch

Until his thirties, Spencer's life was good. But chronic pain from a traumatic leg and ankle injury as a teenager resulted in Spencer becoming addicted to opiates.

For a while, he managed daily pain with over-the-counter medication, but eventually the hurting became so intense that he was not able to care for and play with his children. The next couple of years consisted of Spencer seeking opiates, struggling to find and maintain jobs, and crumbled relationships. There were multiple failed attempts at detox programs. Upon arriving in Syracuse, Spencer contacted Helio Health and scheduled his first appointment. In treatment, he felt supported and understood and was eager to work toward recovery.

Today Spencer is happily married and shares a wonderful home with his wife and children. He has been substance-free since August 2019. While he still has challenges, he uses the skills he learned to overcome them. He feels that life is a gift and wants people to know that if they are struggling with mental health and/or substance use, they can join the recovery family at Helio Health.
